NATIONAL ANTHEM PROTOCOL:

Student-athletes and coaches from both teams will line up on their respective extended free throw lines, facing midcourt for the playing of the National Anthem.

STARTING LINEUP PROTOCOL:

Visiting team starters and coaching staff, followed by Notre Dame starters and coaching staff.

TEAM TIMEOUTS:

- Each team has three 30-second timeouts per game, two of which may be carried over to the second half.
- Each team has one 60-second timeout which may be used any time during the game.
- If the game goes to overtime, each team is awarded a single timeout once play resumes.

The first horn will sound at the end of the assigned time for each media timeout, followed by a horn to resume play 15 seconds later.

When a timeout is granted and creates a dead ball with 30 seconds or less before any of the media timeout marks (16:00, 12:00, 8:00 and 4:00), or creates the first dead ball after the media marks, that timeout will become the scheduled electronic media timeout.

HALFTIME:

Halftime is 15 minutes. Playing floor must be clear and available for teams with 5 minutes remaining. **OVERTIME:**

Each overtime period is 5 minutes. There will be a one-minute intermission between the end of the previous period and any additional extra period. Each team will receive one called timeout, 2:15 in length (2:00 first horn) for each extra period.



Row F (Seats 1-12), Row G (Seats 1-11), Row H (Seats 1-5)






BUS ROUTE


